What a year! Our contributions, literature sales, magazine sales, and subscriptions to the *Al-Anon Family Groups Mobile App* all ended the year above budget. The annual transfer from the Reserve Fund to the General Fund was returned!

There was no way to anticipate the fellowship's response to the release of *A Little Time for Myself* (B-34) with sales of \$908,567. This is the highest-grossing year for literature sales.

Our message to the fellowship has been and continues to be one of gratitude and consistency. The WSO's role of providing services to the fellowship can only be carried out with consistent contributions, the purchase of Conference Approved Literature (CAL), and subscriptions to our *Mobile App* Premium Content and our magazines (*The Forum, Le lien, and en accion*).
