We will facilitate monthly meetings the 1st Monday of the month at CRUSH and continuing our family night at ASAC the 2nd Wednesday of the month. We will meet at Sedlacek on a quarterly basis to support families in their program. Carolyn also attended the 2025 Iowa Governor's Conference on Substance Abuse and has printed business cards for the district. She continues to look for ways to get Al-Anon's message into the hands of schools, professionals, and those most in need.
