

Iowa Area Officers, Delegate & Coordinators Resume

Iowa Area Officer Qualifications:

In order to benefit from service experience, Iowa Area Officers will be elected from outgoing Iowa Area Officers and District Representatives who have served a full three-year term in the Iowa Area. Also eligible will be past District Representatives who have served and remained active in the Iowa Area.

Active' for Area Officer requires all of the following: (10/08/22)

- A. Regular attendance at Al-Anon meetings.
- B. Attendance at Iowa AWSC and Iowa Area Assemblies (minimum of three each year, in the full current term).
- C. Participation in Iowa service work at any level and have relinquished voting rights in other Area/District within the WSC structure.
- D. Be able to become Al-Anon Member Involved In Alateen Service AMIAS Certified in good standing in accordance with the Iowa Alateen Safety and Behavior Requirements.

In order to meet service attendance requirements, it is the responsibility of individuals who desire to stand for an Iowa Area officer position, to declare their intention to the Area Secretary prior to or at the June assembly meeting of the election year.

Iowa Area Coordinator Qualifications:

Any active Iowa Al-Anon member, who also meets the qualifications for Iowa GR, relinquishes voting rights in other Areas/Districts within the WSC structure and has a good understanding of the Steps, Traditions and the basic Al-Anon program may stand for a coordinator's position. At least two years in the Al-Anon program is suggested.

Members who are also members of A.A., or have been members of A.A., do not serve as Group Representative (GR), District Representative (DR), Area Delegate, World Service Conference member, alternate to any of these service positions or on any committee of the World Service Office. (Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual)

Officer Positions Include: Delegate, Alt Delegate, Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer

Coordinator Positions Include: Alateen, Archives, Group Records, Literature, Newsletter, Public Outreach, Technology, Website
